

**August 28 – September 1, 2017: Technical University of Munich to host the 43<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Very Large Data Bases**

**A focus on emerging applications in data management at this year's conference**

First held in 1975, the annual International Conference on Very Large Data Bases (VLDB) has become one of the premiere meeting places for experts working in the fields of data management and database and information systems research and development.

The Technical University of Munich with its renown database research profile will host of this year's event. The VLDB 2017 conference is held as part of TUM's 50 year anniversary of establishing Computer Science as a scientific discipline in Munich. The TUM professors Alfons Kemper and Thomas Neumann serve as General Chairs of this most prestigious database conference: With over 1,000 participants from around the globe expected, the VLDB 2017 will feature research talks, tutorials, demonstrations, and workshops. There will be a focus on issues in data management, database and information systems research, since they are the technological cornerstones of the emerging applications of the 21st century.

The conference serves as the annual gathering for the US-based non-profit organization, the Very Large Data Base Endowment (VLDB Endowment), which was founded for the sole purpose of promoting and exchanging scholarly work in databases and related fields throughout the world. Since 1992, the endowment has published the *VLDB Journal* and also sponsors various scholarly activities. It has established a program providing support to summer schools and training courses. This year's conference is receiving sponsorship from a leading global database and IT companies, including: Couchbase, Google, Microsoft, Oracle, Recruit, SAP, Tableau, Teradata.
